ROAD RESURFACING SCHEDULE Gene Smith

<u>Monday September 18th:</u> Crack filling which does not require road closure. You may be delayed 5 or 10 minutes.

Friday September 22nd: Total road closure for the HA5 application. This is critical. You CANNOT drive on or park on the HOA roads/parking areas for 24 hours beginning EARLY (7 am or before) Friday morning.

If you need to drive that day you will need to park off site (the night before if possible) and walk to your car. The <u>only approved parking</u> is at the new Del Sol clubhouse and if you do this, you'll want to leave a viewable note saying you're from Canoa Vistas, which should prevent your being towed.

Volunteers needed: If you can volunteer for the following please contact me:

- 1. To help with shuttles between CV and the Del Sol clubhouse
- 2. To be available should someone not parked off-site unexpectedly have to get somewhere.

Regardless if you need to get out that day, you're going to have to make it up to the Canoa Vistas Entrance by foot!
